RelImagine: Mastermind Collective for Administrators

Led by RelImagine and Shifting Schools founder Jeff Utecht, the RelImagine Mastermind Collective has been created as a place and time for Administrators tasked with making Distance Learning work for their schools, teachers, students and families, to come together and collectively share ideas, challenges and successes.

You will be encouraged to bring data, ask questions, to share, and to give others feedback during the hour long Mastermind collective, scheduled every other week for 4 sessions.

THE SESSIONS:

#1 ASYNCHRONOUS VS SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

We will focus on research best practices for online learning along with data that we are gathering across the state about what is working and what is not.

DATA POINT: Districts/Schools who have more asynchronous time in their schedule are reporting parent and student 'happiness' with their program/schedule

#2 SCHEDULES

Bring your school schedule and based on Session 1 we will look at your school specific schedule and how it does or does not align with best practice and the data we are gathering together across this state.

DATA POINT: Districts who have regularly scheduled zoom meetings more than 2.5 hours a day are starting to receive push back from the community.

#3 PROVIDING FEEDBACK AND SUPPORT TO TEACHERS FROM A DISTANCE

Your use to doing walkthroughs and meeting with PLCs. How do you give feedback and support educators in this new distance/hybrid learning education system?

DATA POINT: Administrators who lead by example and use the same tools with their staff that they require staff to use with students make staff feel supported in their efforts.

#4 COMMUNICATION

Education of the future will require administrators to embrace the use of video and social media to communicate with staff, students and the wider community. We will share what districts are doing and allow you to talk and hear from what is working in other districts.

PRO TIP: You get on the cell phone you win!

What do you need?

- A quiet space for an hour, once every two weeks for 4 sessions.
- A device that can access the internet and is capable of getting you into Zoom, (The ability to turn on your video or audio is handy but not necessary;
- A willingness to share & a willingness to fail fast, fail proud! (aka a growth mindset).
